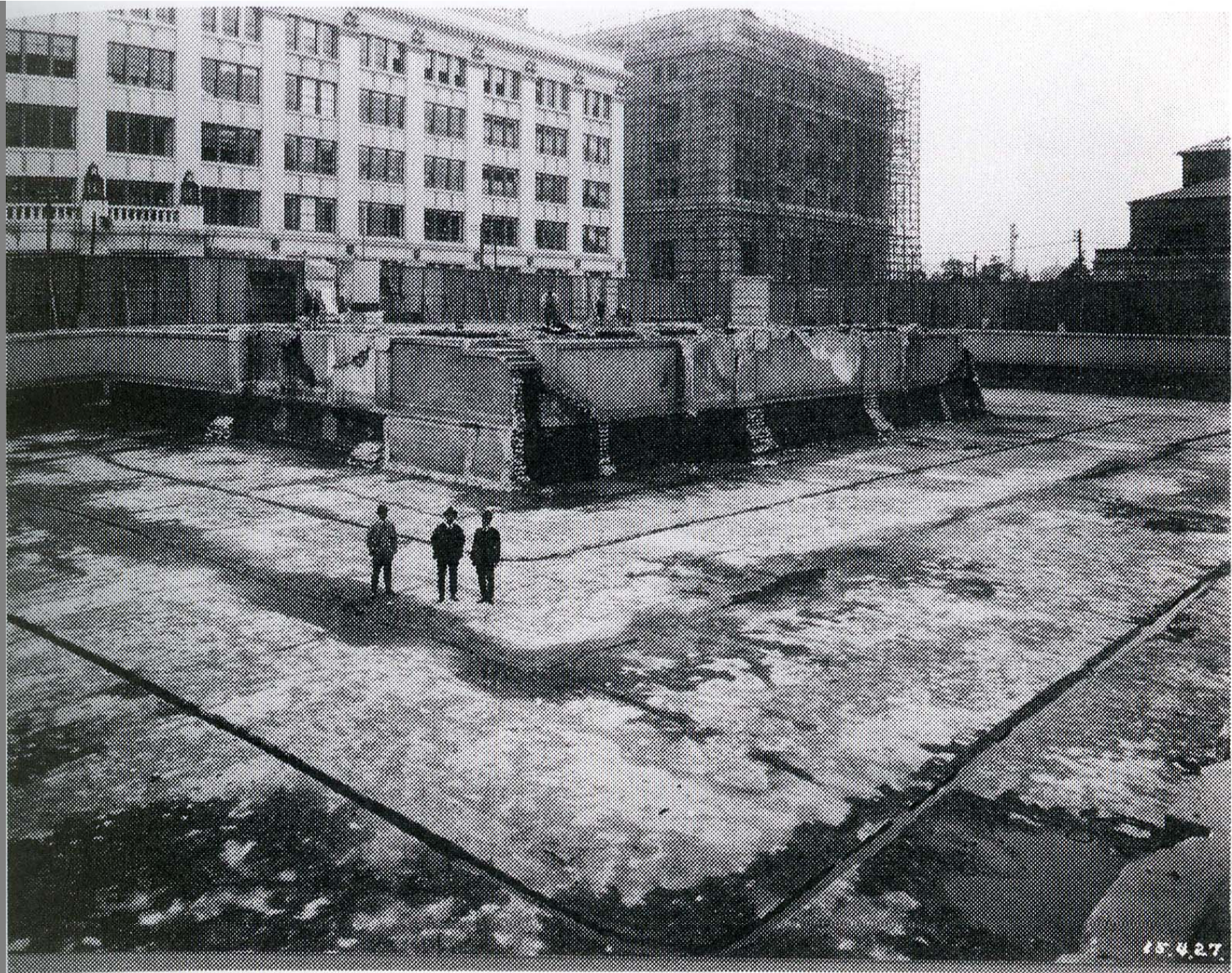

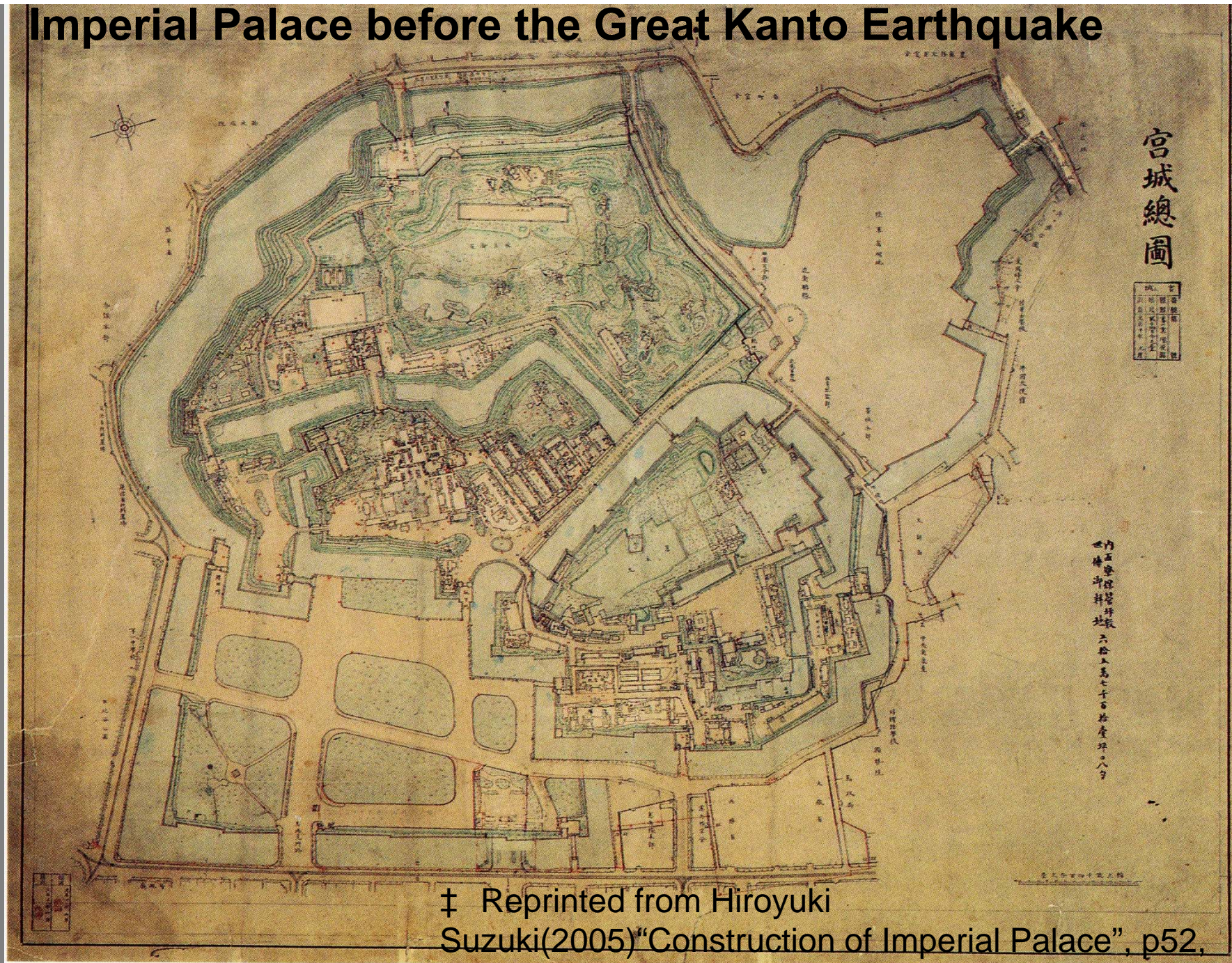

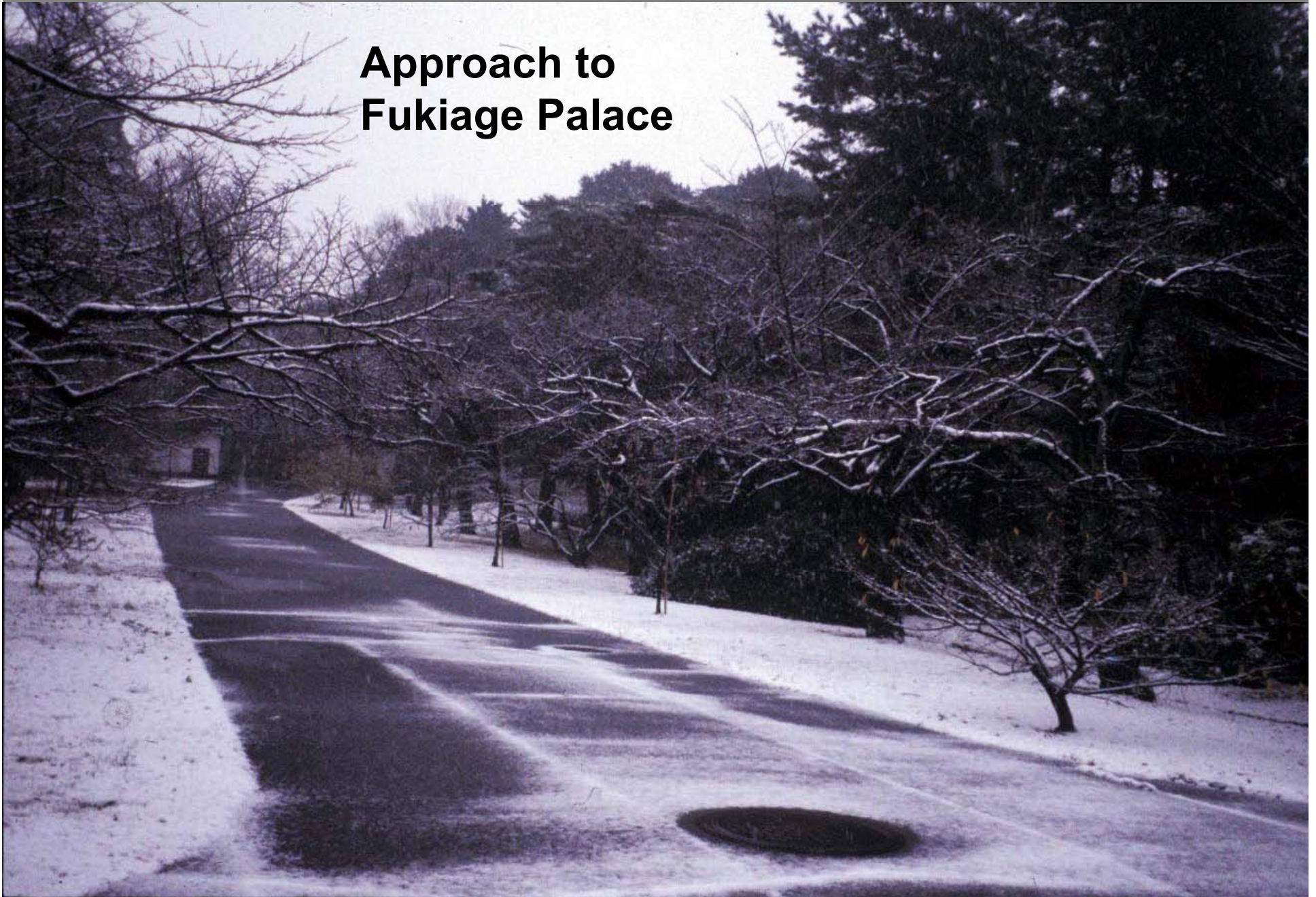

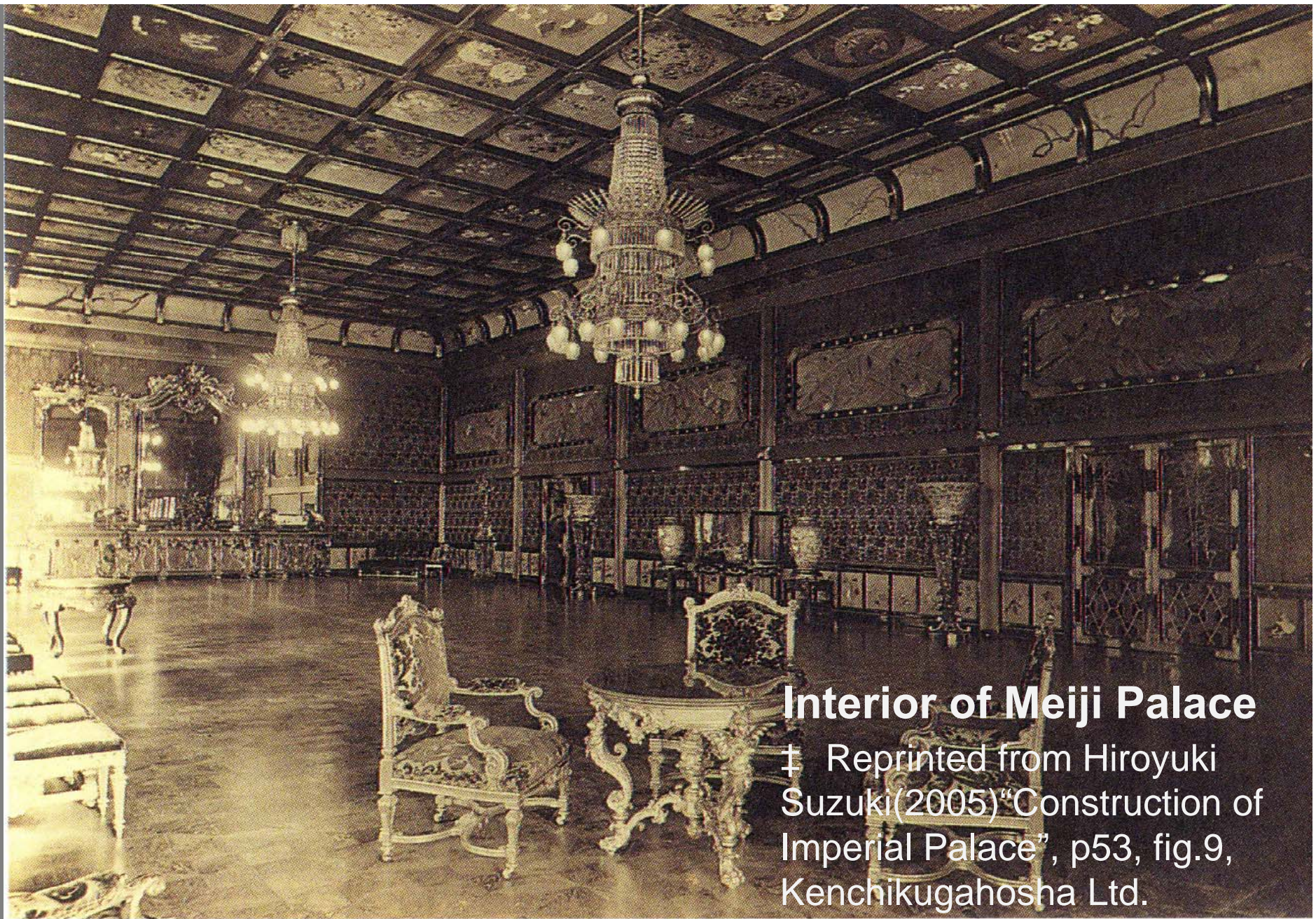

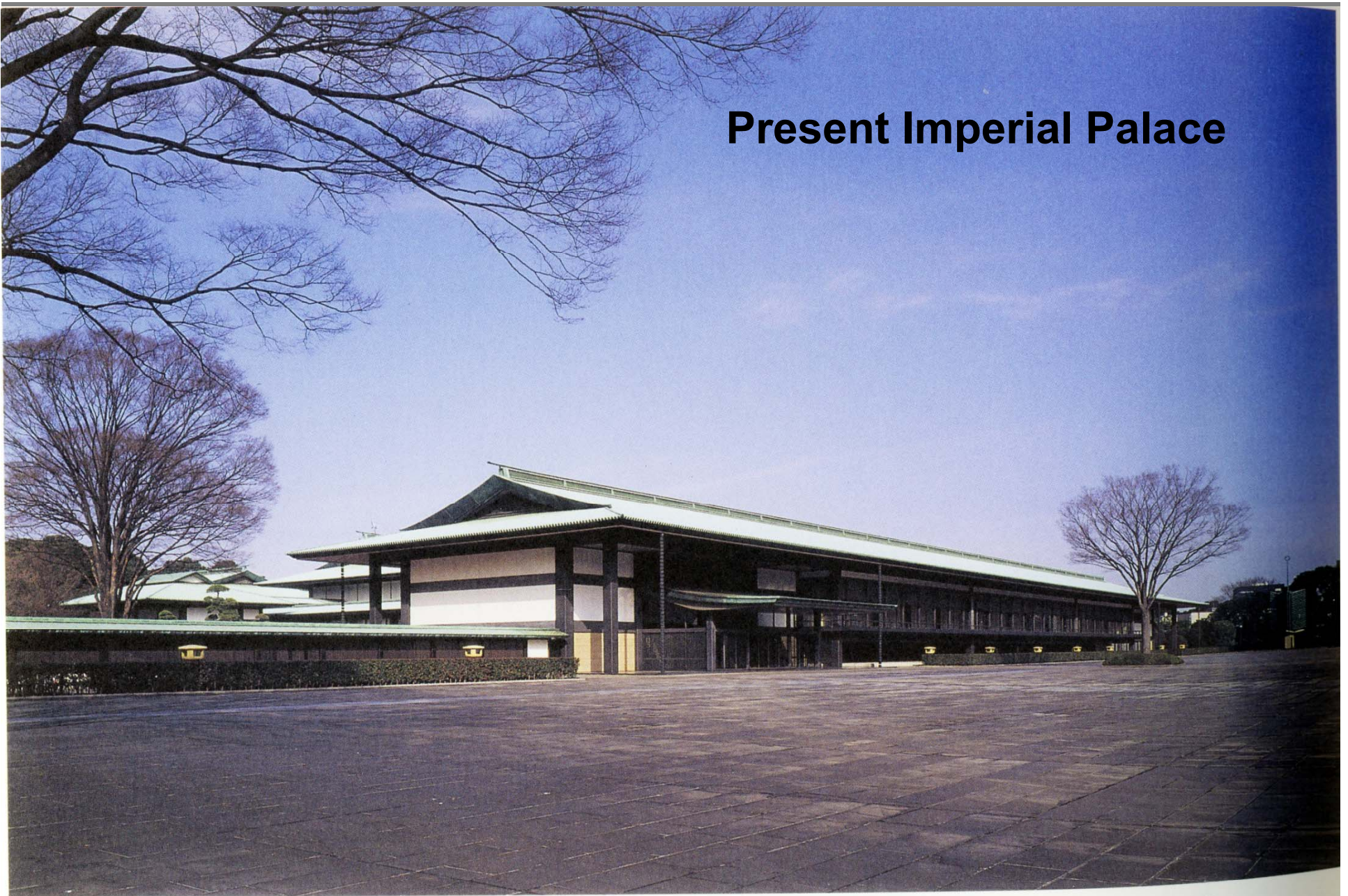

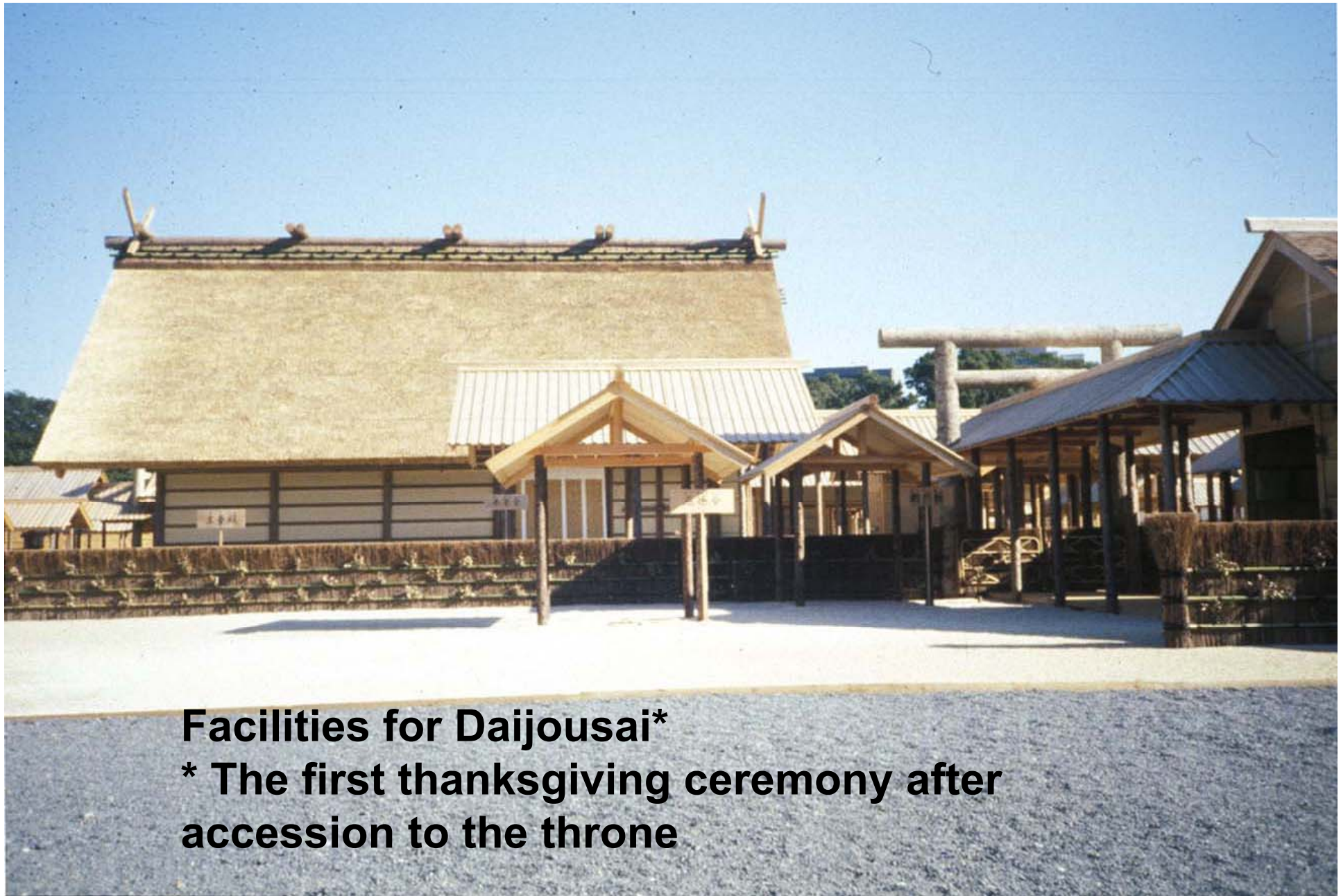

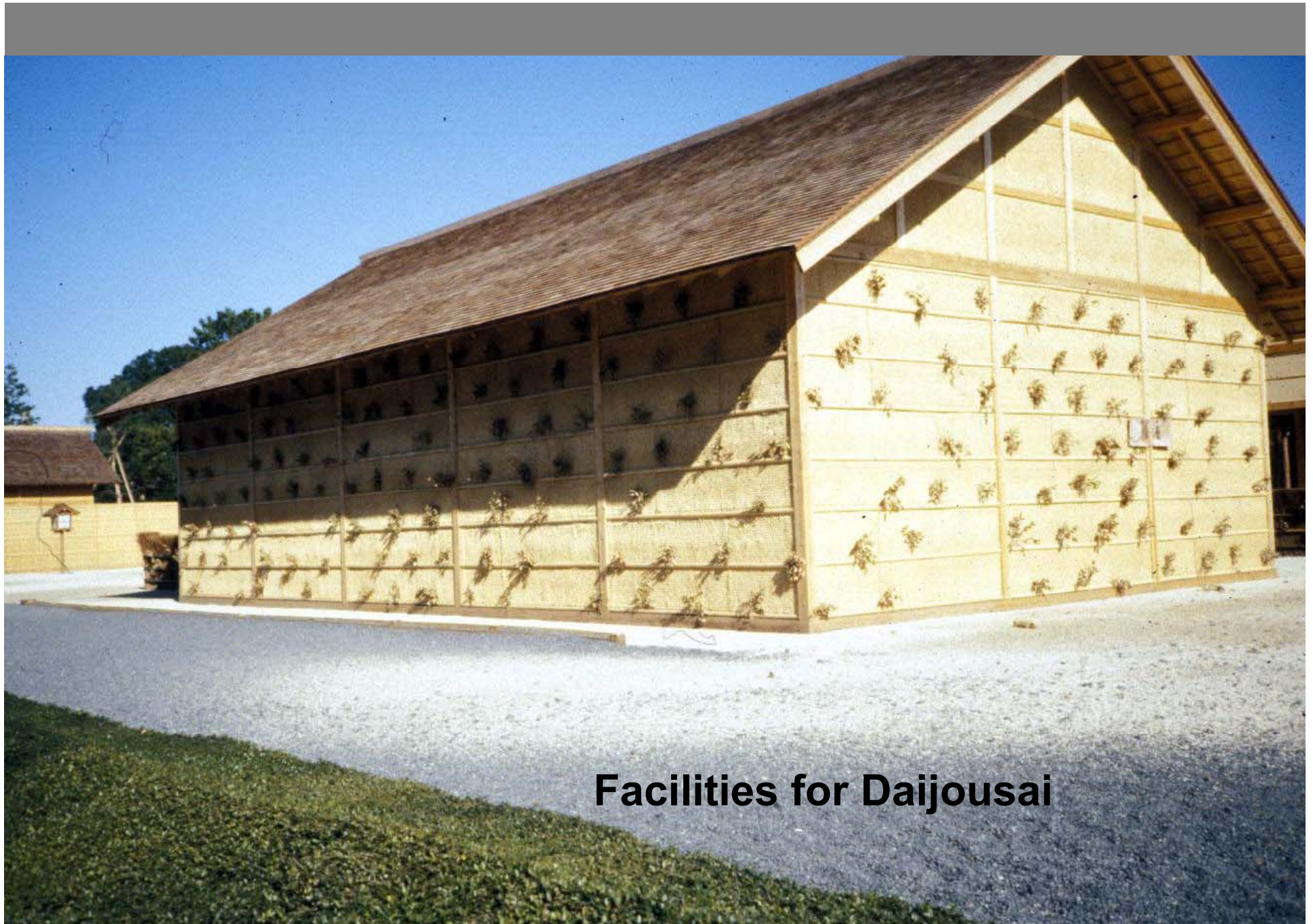

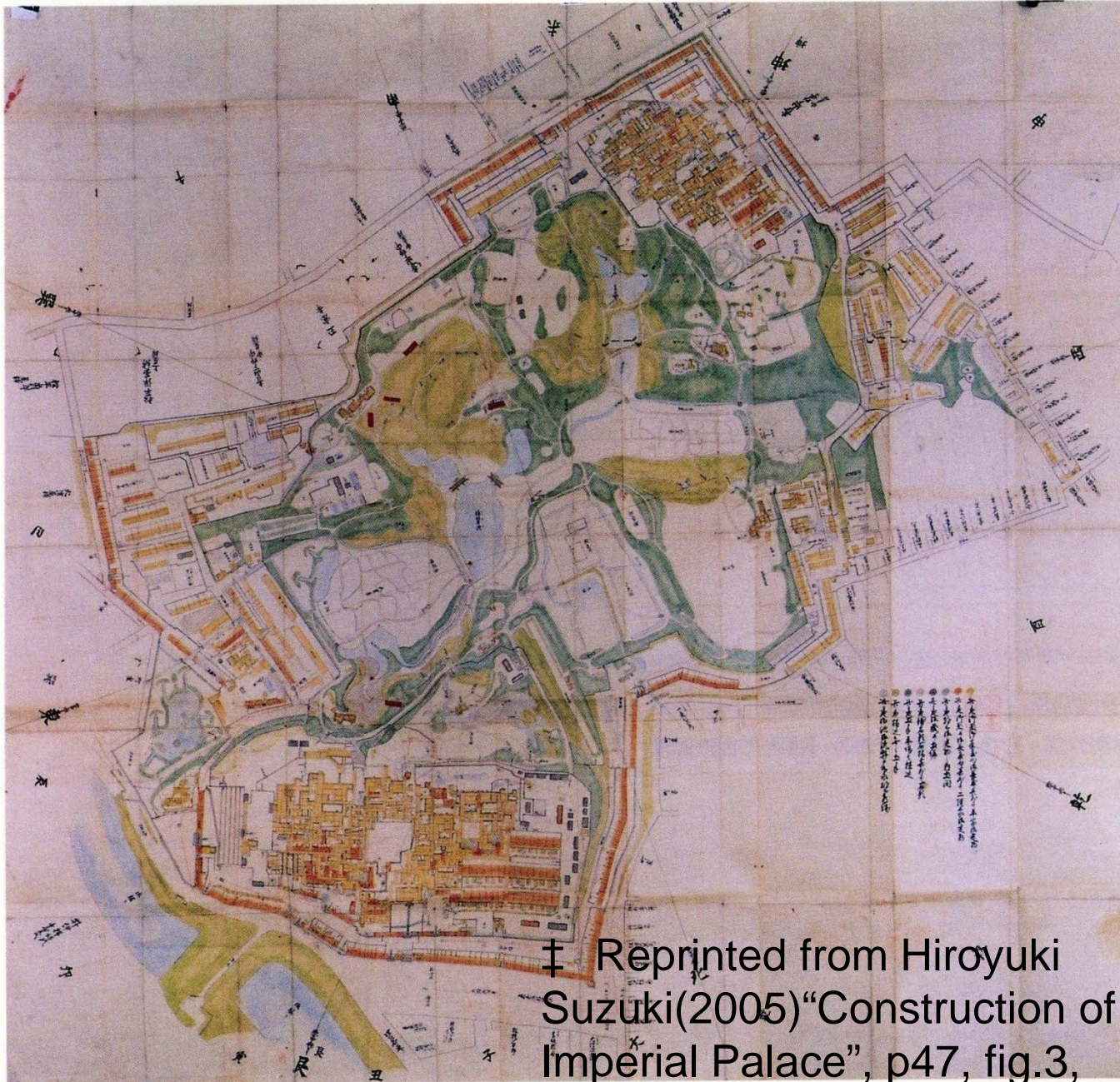

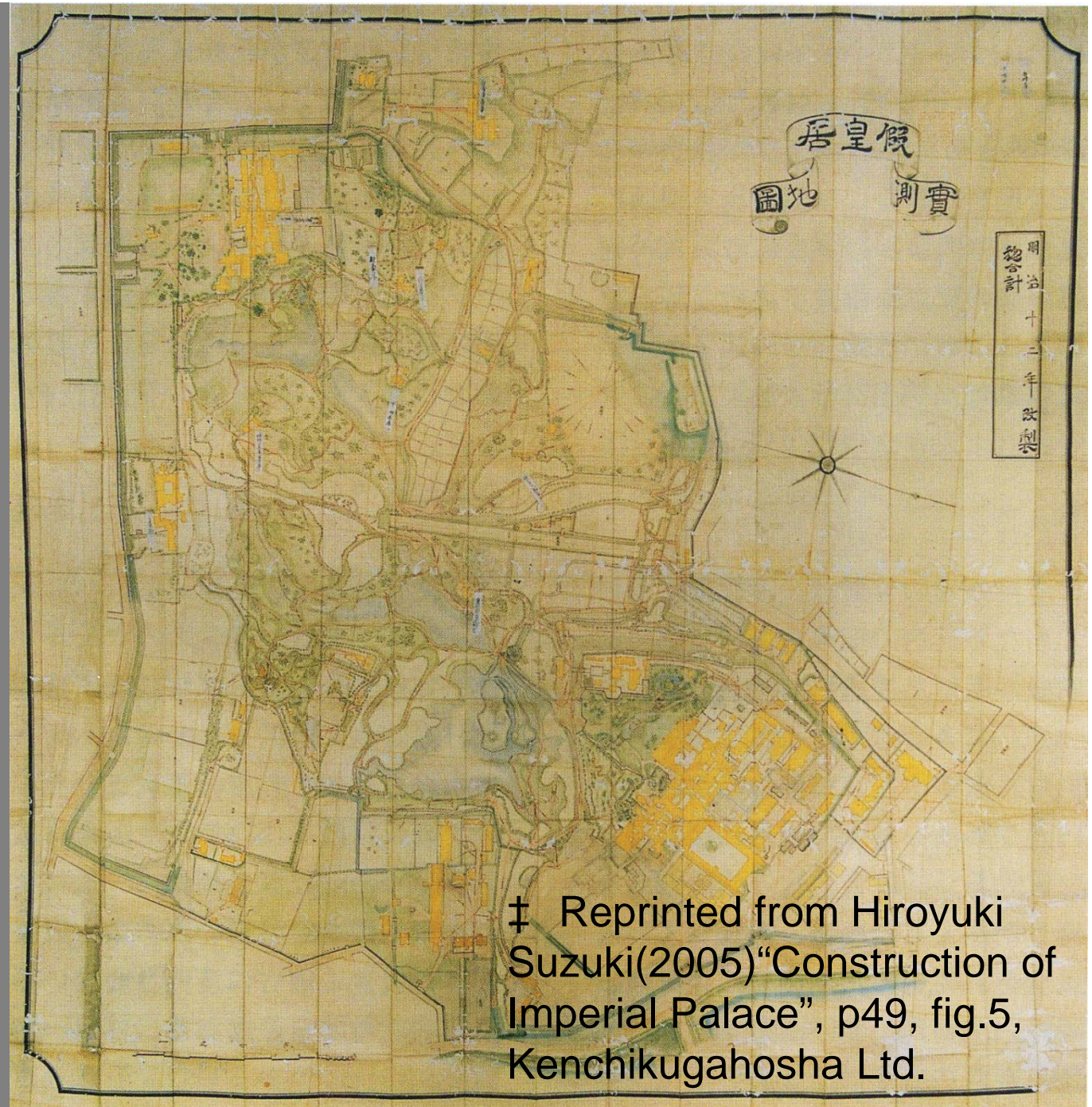

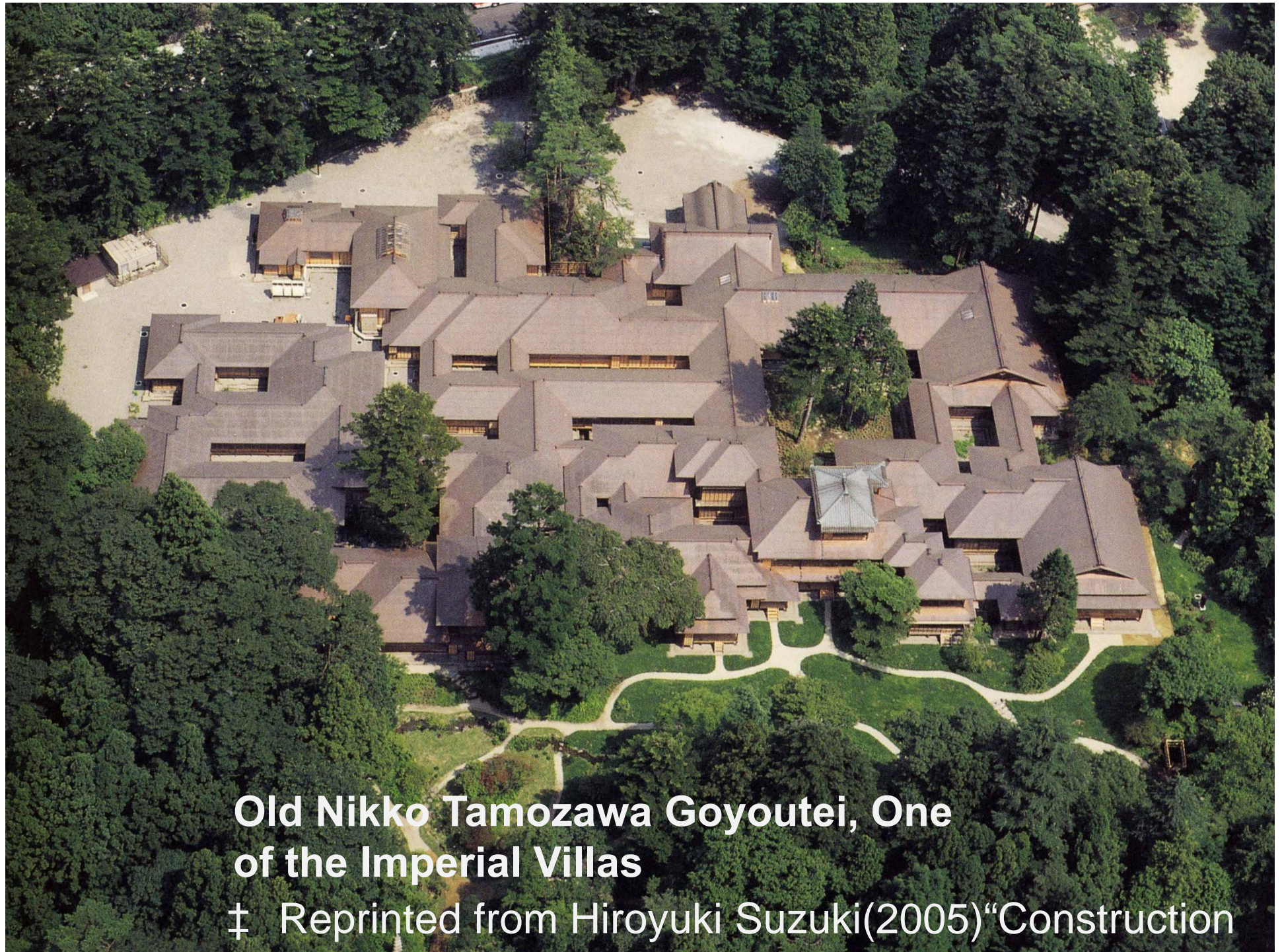


# Survey Map of Temporary Imperial Palace

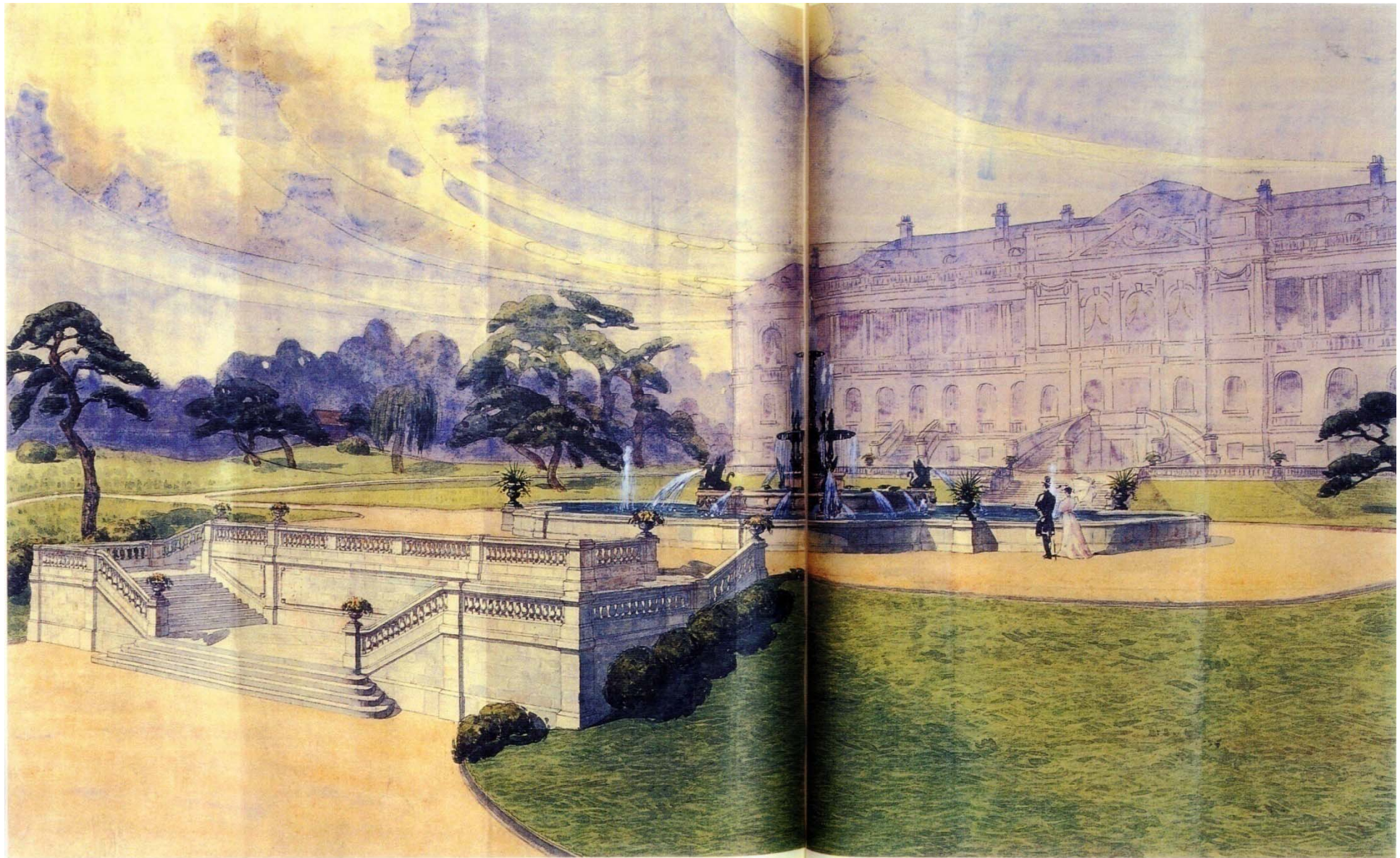

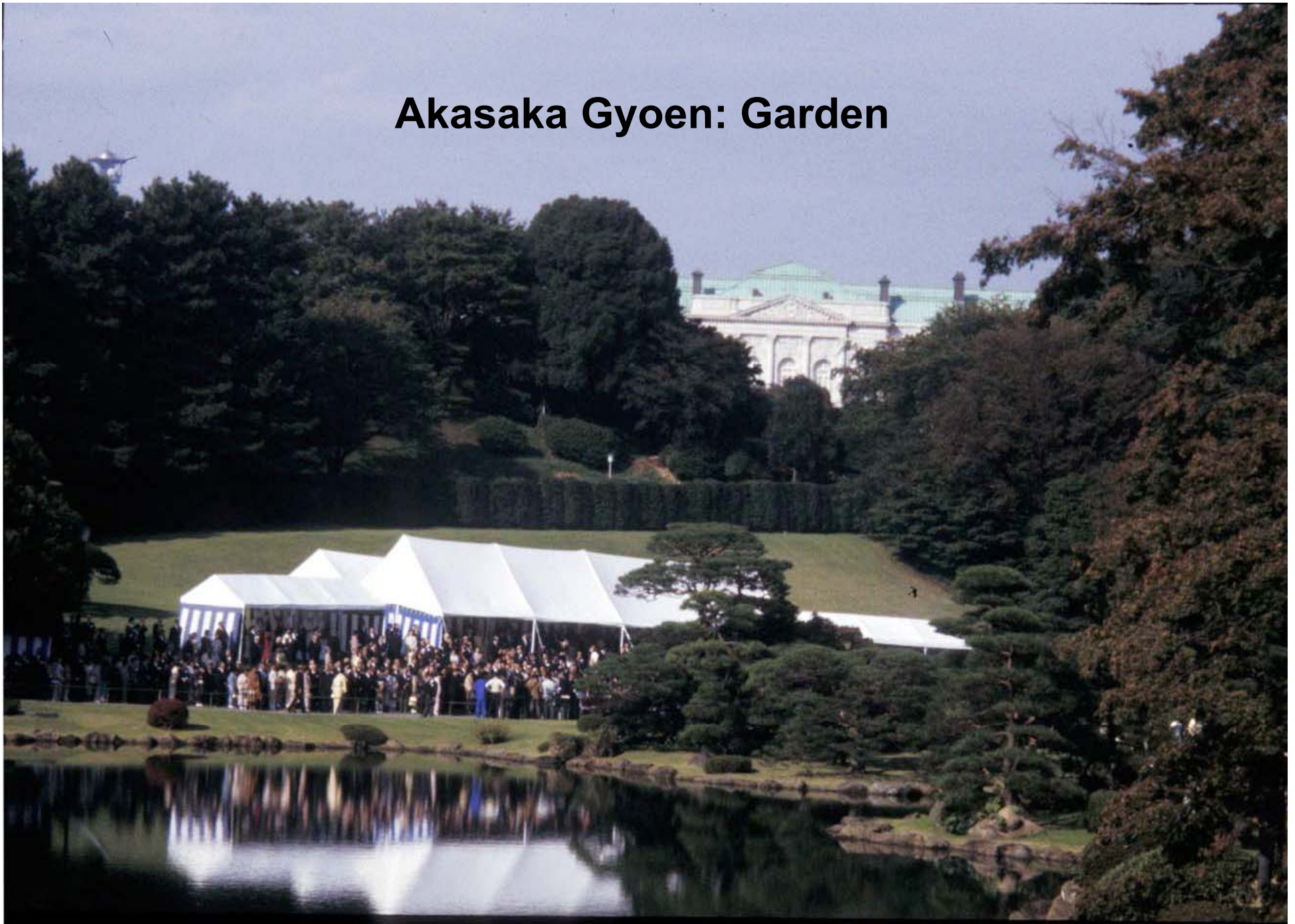

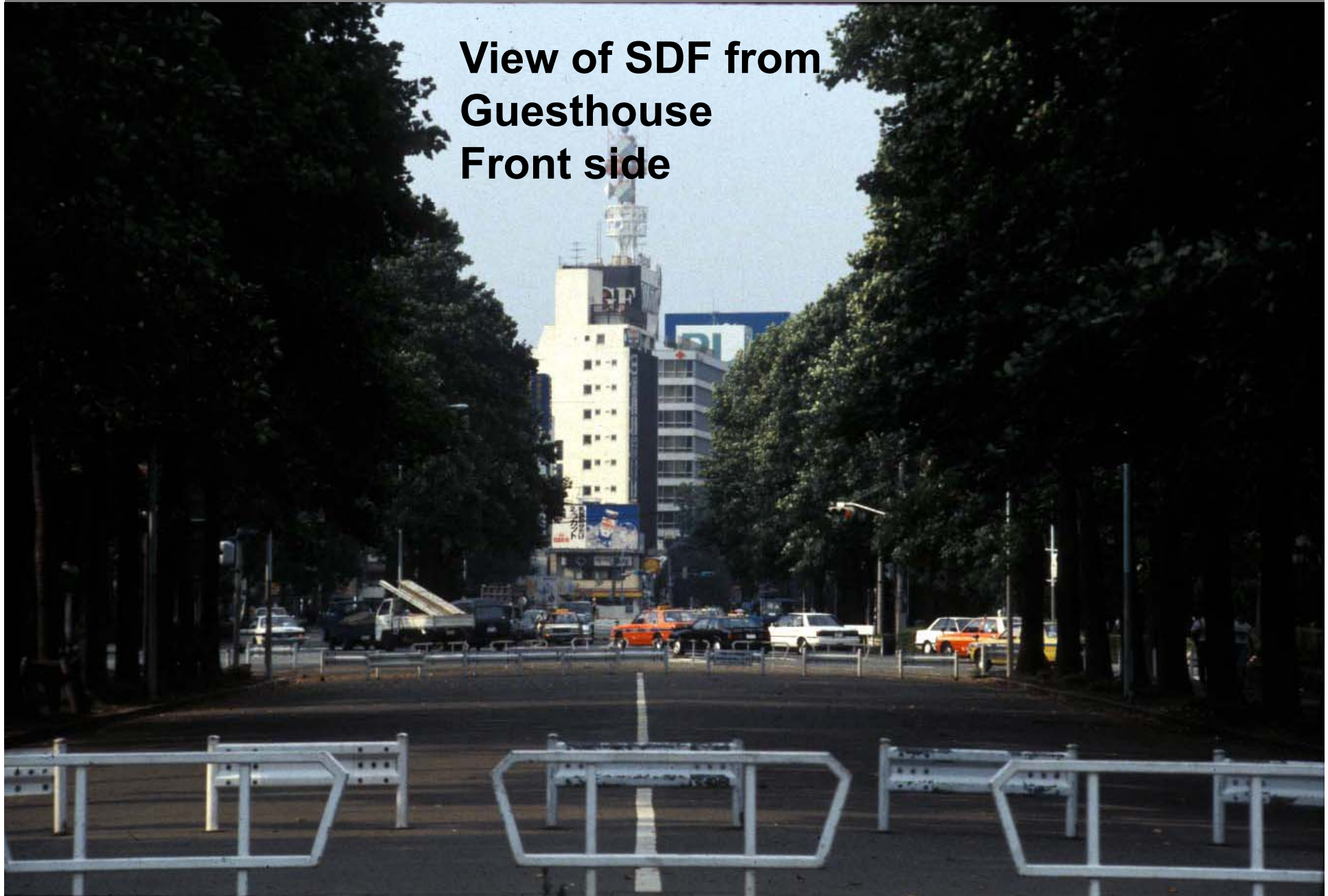

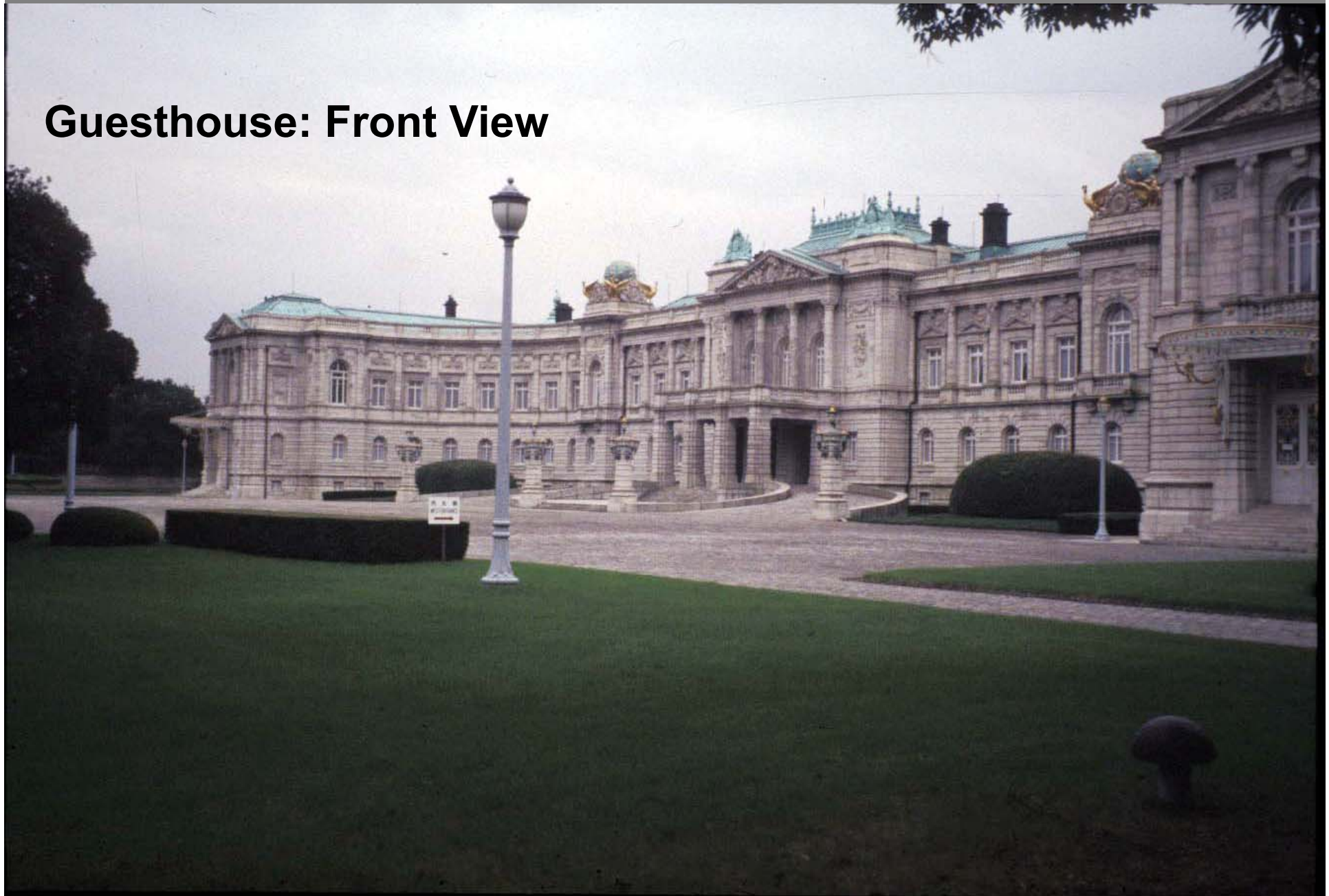

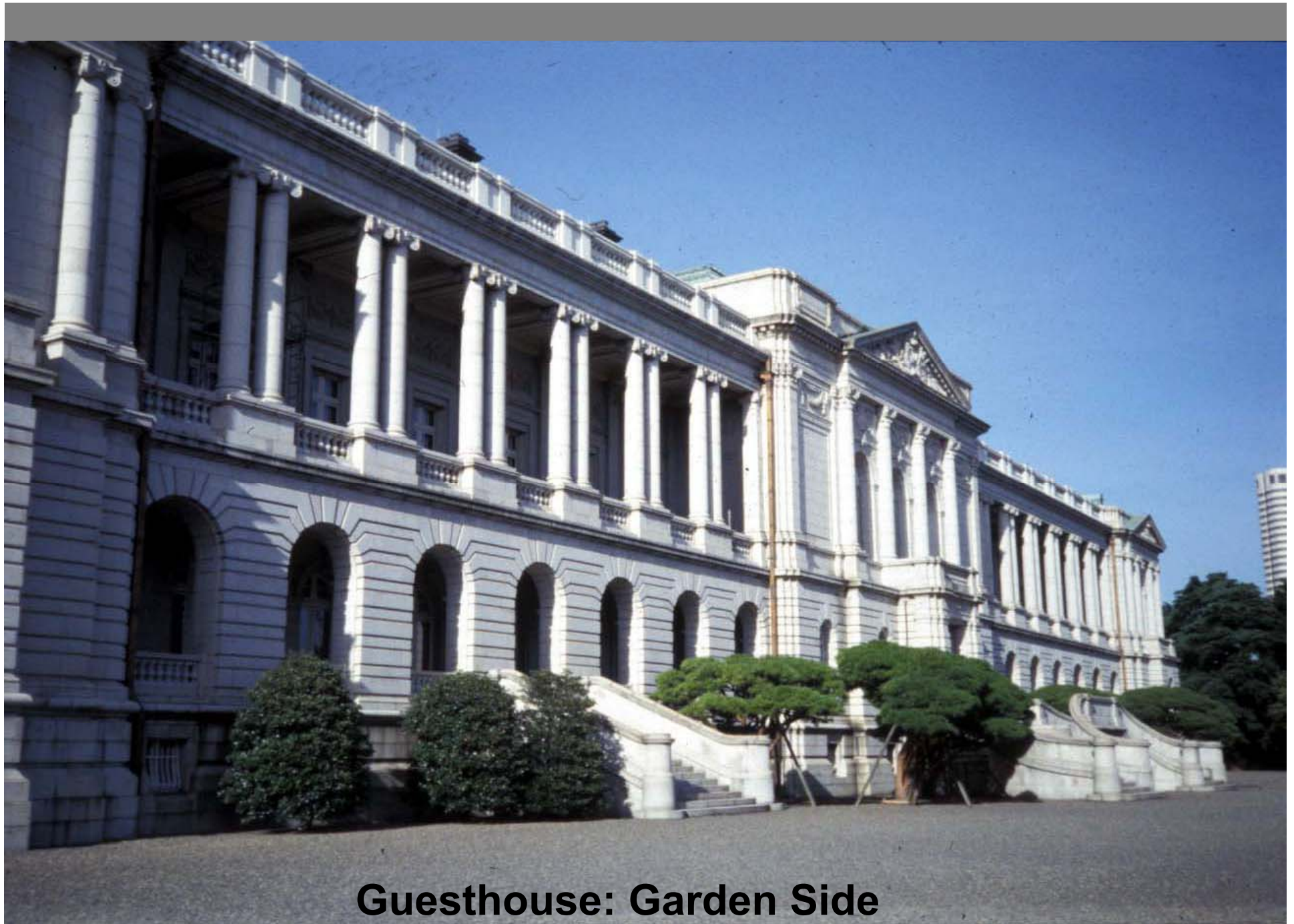

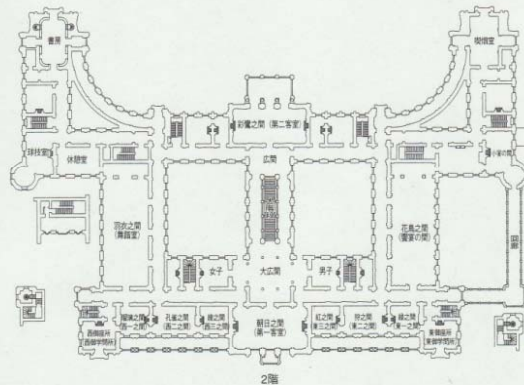
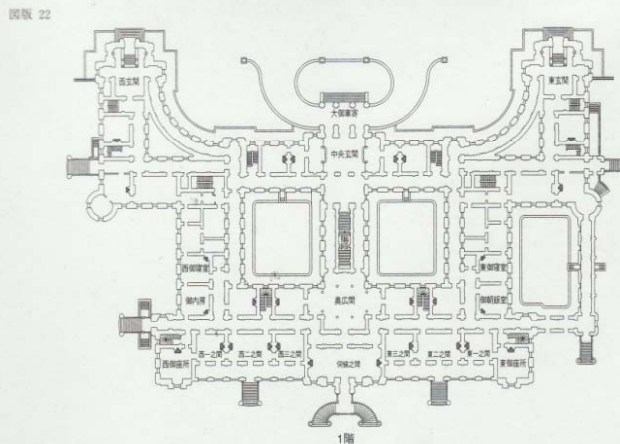


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**Floor Plan for the 1<sup>st</sup> Floor (Chart3.1.1-1)**

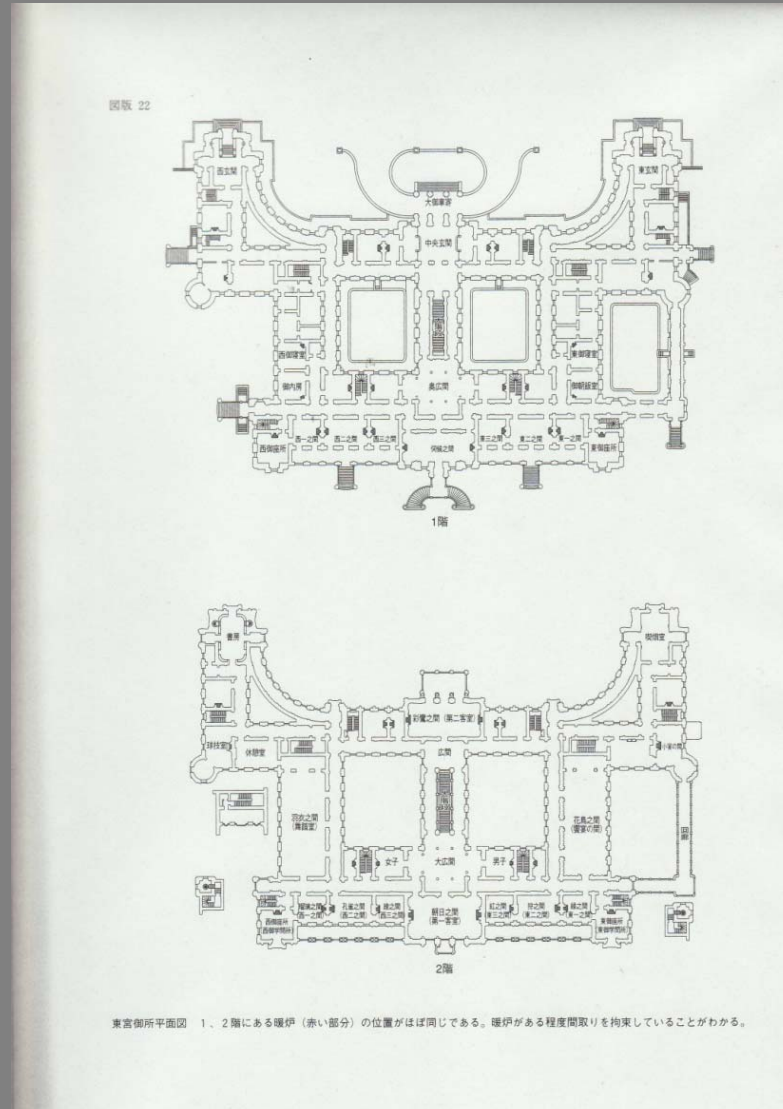

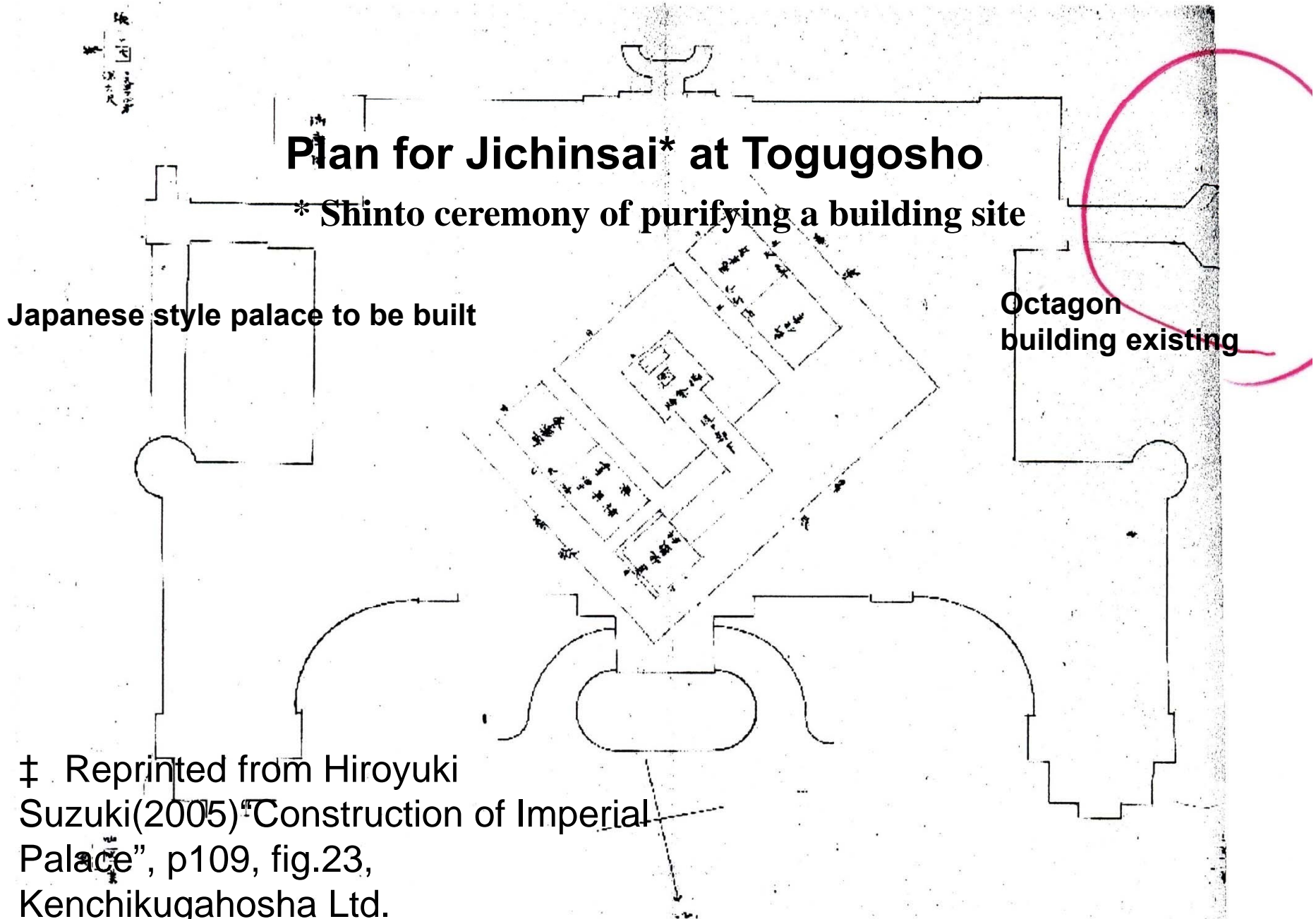
