5. An Amazing Story -Love Song (Razón de amor) (around 1205)

In Spain, "siesta" is an important custom, where the local people have a

quite filling lunch with wine and enjoy a slow and relaxing time in the afternoon. Siesta clearly divides the daytime into two, creating different lives in the morning and in the evening. This is a nice enhancement to daily life, making us feel as if we have two days in one.
