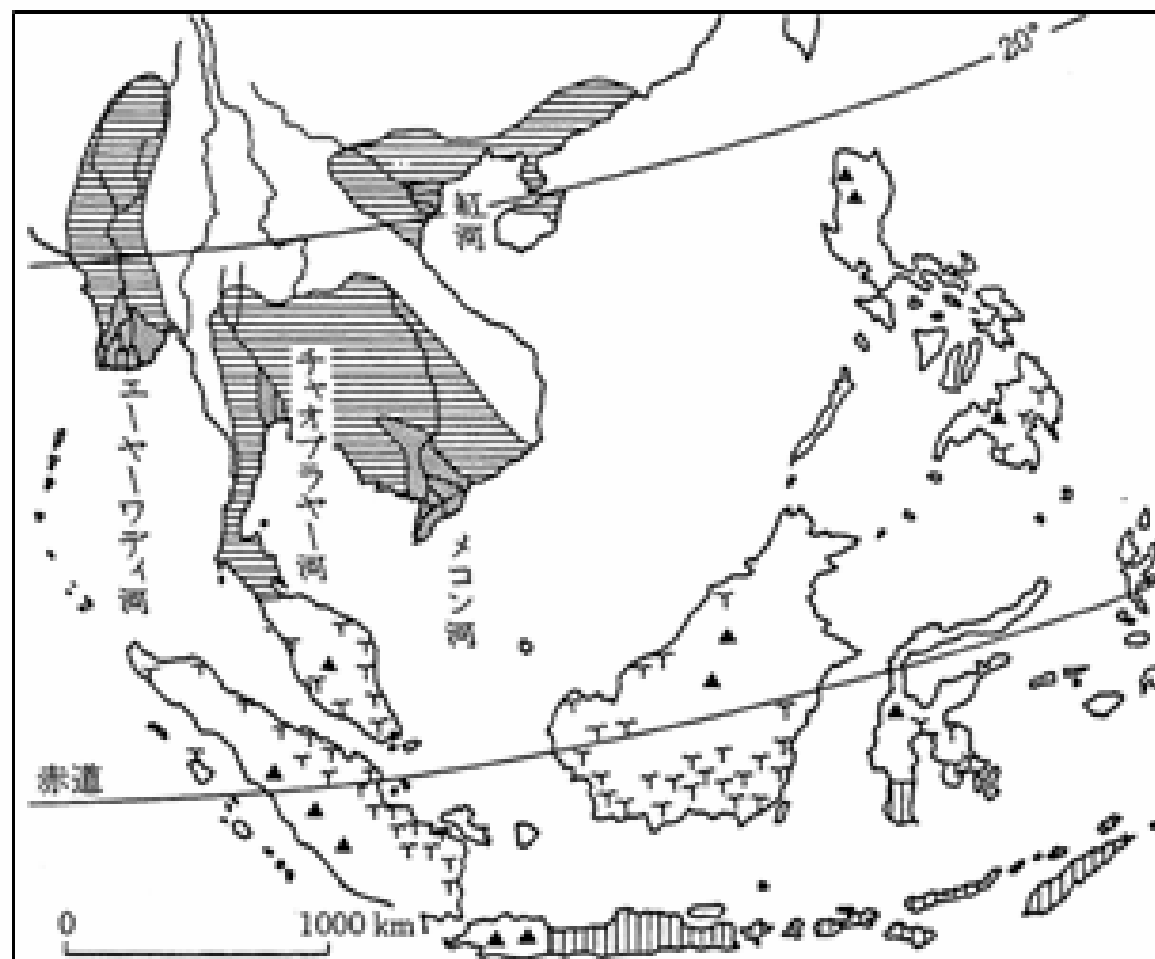

Thai Monarchy: Amicable Adjustment to Outer Culture

- Frontier territory: Chao Phraya Delta
- Economic history that evaded colonialism

- Later half of 1950s

Industrial strategies were taken within the framework of liberalized policies.

Thai society accepted free economic policies.

Indonesia: Antagonistic Adjustment to Outer Culture

- Java and the outside islands
- From ancient times a matured farming culture had already existed: Java
- Tropical rain forests and seaports: outside islands
- Colonial period under the occupation of the Netherlands
- Politics after independence: Policy of development
